**ANNOUNCEMENT
MOUNTAIN GUIDES TRAINING SHORT COURSE**

24th JULY 2020

Introduction

The Government of Tanzania through the Ministry of Natural Resources and Tourism is planning to implement a countrywide system of tour guides registration, certification and accreditation in compliance with the Tourism Act No. 11 of 2008, section 42 when read together with Tourism (Tour Guides) Regulations, 2013 and Guidelines on Registration and Licensing of Tourism Operations. The Act stipulates that tour guides should be registered, certified and licensed in order to operate in the tourism industry. In respect to this, the College of African Wildlife Management, Mweka (CAWM) has been chosen to train Mountain Tour Guides. Therefore, this announcement is for the **11th intake**, Mountain Tour Guides Training. The training is expected to start **from 05th October 2020 to 24th October 2020** at the College of African Wildlife Management-Mweka. The training will be conducted through lectures and field practical training.

The course will cover the following areas;

1. Introduction to Tourism and Protected Areas
2. Biological Resources identification and General Mountain Ecology
3. Mountain Physical Resources Identification and interpretation
4. Tour guiding skills and techniques
5. First Aid, Emergence care and Wilderness Rescue

Prerequisites;

1. At least Ordinary Certificate of Secondary Education (OCSE)/ any other recognized qualification
2. Be a member of a recognized Mountain Tour Guides Association in Tanzania

Cost of Training

The tuition fee for each participant will be **TZS 800,000/= or equivalent** excluding accommodation, meals and field training gears.

Mode of Application

Prospective participants are supposed to confirm their participation by submitting filled forms available at the admissions secretary or register using the link in our website (www.mwekawildlife.ac.tz) by latest 2nd October 2020.

Registration shall take place on 05th October 2020 with the bank slip for the payment of tuition fee. Registration will strictly be for one day from 8:00am to 4:00pm at the admissions office. Those who had earlier paid tuition fees should consider attending this intake.
