### INVITATION FOR APPLICATIONS FOR 2017/2018 ADMISSIONS

The College of African Wildlife Management (CAWM), Mweka is the leading institution in professional and technical training in wildlife- and tourism management. It was established in 1963 by the Act of Parliament Number 8 of 1964. The College is registered and accredited by the National Council for Technical Education (NACTE) and recognized as a Centre of Excellence by the East African Community (EAC) and Southern African Development Community (SADC).

The Rector is hereby inviting applications from qualified Tanzanian and non-Tanzanian candidates for the academic year 2017/2018 intake on the following training programs:

**1. Postgraduate Diploma in Wildlife Management - One-Year Programme**

Minimum entry qualification is a Bachelor Degree in Biological Sciences, Botany, Ecology, Environmental Science, Conservation Biology, Fisheries, Forest, Natural Resources Management, Agriculture, Veterinary Medicine and related fields from a recognized University. A prior work experience in wildlife conservation, natural resources and environmental management sectors will be an added advantage.

**2. Postgraduate Diploma in Tourism Planning and Management - One-Year Programme**

Minimum entry qualification is a Bachelor Degree in Wildlife Management, Tourism, Business Administration, Mass Communication, Biological Sciences, Law, Anthropology, Sociology, Community/Rural Development, Natural Resources Management and related fields from recognized University. A prior work experience in wildlife conservation, tourism, natural resources and environmental management sectors will be an added advantage.

**3. Bachelor Degree in Wildlife Management (NTA 7&8) - Three Year Programme**

Minimum entry qualification is **EITHER** an Advanced Certificate of Secondary Education Examination (or equivalent) with at least two principle passes in science subjects: Biology, Geography, Chemistry, Physics, Agriculture, Nutrition and Mathematics. Applicants must have a minimum aggregate point of 4.0 **OR** minimum **3.0GPA** of Ordinary Diploma in Wildlife Management OR Wildlife Tourism OR related discipline from institutions recognized by NACTE

**4. Bachelor Degree in Wildlife Tourism (NTA 7&8) - Three Year Programme**

Minimum entry qualification is **EITHER** an Advanced Certificate of Secondary Education Examination (or equivalent) with at least two principle passes in science subjects: Biology, Geography, Chemistry, Physics, Agriculture, Nutrition and Mathematics. Applicants must have a minimum aggregate point of 4.0 **OR** minimum **3.0GPA** of Ordinary Diploma in

Wildlife Management **OR** Wildlife Tourism OR related discipline from institutions recognized by NACTE.

**5. Diploma in Wildlife Management (NTA 5&6) – Two Year Programme**

Minimum entry qualification is **EITHER** an Advanced Certificate of Secondary Education Examination (ACSEE) from National Examinations Council of Tanzania (NECTA) or a certificate equivalent to ACSEE approved by NACTE with minimum of one principle pass and one subsidiary in the following subjects: Biology, Chemistry, Physics, Geography, Mathematics, Agriculture, English and Nutrition **OR** Possession of Basic Technician Certificate in Wildlife Management or Wildlife Tourism from the College of African Wildlife Management, Mweka; **OR** Possession of Technical Certificate in Wildlife Management and Law Enforcement (BTCWLE) from Pasiansi Wildlife Institute **OR** Possession of certificate equivalent to NTA 4 from the institutions recognised by NACTE in the following areas: Beekeeping, Forest, Fishery, Livestock production and Agriculture

**6. Diploma in Wildlife Tourism (NTA 5&6) – Two Year Programme**

Minimum entry qualification is **EITHER** an Advanced Certificate of Secondary Education Examination (ACSEE) from National Examinations Council of Tanzania (NECTA) or a certificate equivalent to ACSEE approved by NACTE with minimum of one principle pass and one subsidiary in the following subjects: Biology, Chemistry, Physics, Geography, Mathematics, Agriculture, History, English and Nutrition **OR** Possession of Basic Technician Certificate in Wildlife Management or Wildlife Tourism from the College of African Wildlife Management, Mweka **OR** Possession of certificate equivalent to NTA 4 from the institutions recognised by NACTE in the following areas: Tourism Management and Tour Guiding

**7. Technician Certificate in Wildlife Management (NTA 5) - One-Year Programme**

Minimum entry qualification is **EITHER** an Advanced Certificate of Secondary Education Examination (ACSEE) from National Examinations Council of Tanzania (NECTA) or a certificate equivalent to ACSEE approved by NACTE with minimum of one principle pass and one subsidiary in the following subjects: Biology, Chemistry, Physics, Geography, Mathematics, Agriculture, English and Nutrition **OR** Possession of Basic Technician Certificate in Wildlife Management or Wildlife Tourism from the College of African Wildlife Management, Mweka; **OR** Possession of Technical Certificate in Wildlife Management and Law Enforcement (BTCWLE) from Pasiansi Wildlife Institute **OR** Possession of certificate equivalent to NTA 4 from the institutions recognised by NACTE in the following areas: Beekeeping, Forest, Fishery, Livestock production and Agriculture

**8. Technician Certificate in Wildlife Tourism (NTA 5) - One-Year Programme**

Minimum entry qualification is **EITHER** an Advanced Certificate of Secondary Education Examination (ACSEE) from National Examinations Council of Tanzania (NECTA) or a certificate equivalent to ACSEE approved by NACTE with minimum of one principle pass and one subsidiary in the following subjects: Biology, Chemistry, Physics, Geography, Mathematics, Agriculture, History, English and Nutrition **OR** Possession of Basic Technician Certificate in Wildlife Management or Wildlife Tourism from the College of African Wildlife Management, Mweka; **OR** Possession of certificate equivalent to NTA 4 from the institutions recognised by NACTE in the following areas: Tourism Management and Tour Guiding

**9. Basic Technician Certificate in Wildlife Management (NTA 4) - One-Year Programme**

Minimum entry qualification is **EITHER** a Certificate of Secondary Education Examination (CSEE) with a minimum of four passes in the following subjects: Biology, Chemistry, Physics, Geography, Mathematics, Agriculture, English and Nutrition **OR** Possession of Basic Technician Certificate in Wildlife Management and Law Enforcement (BTCWLE) from Pasiansi Wildlife Institute **OR** Possession of Vocational Training Award III in Livestock, Fishery, Agriculture, Beekeeping and Forestry courses from institutions recognized by Vocational Educations and Training Authority (VETA). Applicants applying using VTA III must have obtained four passes in Certificate of Secondary Education Examination (CSEE)

**10. Basic Technician Certificate in Wildlife Tourism (NTA 4) - One-Year Programme**

Minimum entry qualification is **EITHER** a Certificate of Secondary Education Examination (CSEE) with a minimum of four passes in the following subjects: Biology, Chemistry, Physics, Geography, Mathematics, Agriculture, English, History and Nutrition **OR** Possession of Vocational Training Award III in Wildlife Tourism and Tour Guiding courses from institutions recognized by Vocational Educations and Training Authority (VETA). Applicants applying using VTA III must have obtained four passes in Certificate of Secondary Education Examination (CSEE)

**MODE OF APPLICATION**

**CONDITIONS FOR APPLICANTS DIRECT TO THE COLLEGE**

- i. All applications must be accompanied by genuine copies of relevant certificates
- ii. Applications with Foreign Secondary School Certificates should be accompanied by National Examinations Council (NECTA) Equivalence translations
- iii. All applications must be accompanied by a non-refundable application fee of TAS. 10,000/= for Tanzanians and US \$ 15 for foreigners for Postgraduate Diploma, Ordinary Diploma, Technician Certificates and Basic Technician Certificates programmes which should be made to the College Bank Account at NBC Ltd, Moshi branch, Account No. 017105002480; Swift Code: NLCBTZTX for foreign currency payment OR Account No. 01J1039905500 at CRDB Bank Ltd, Moshi Branch for payments made in equivalent Tanzanian Shillings
- iv. Two passport size photographs
- v. Applications without photocopies of certificates and bank pay slip will not be considered
- vi. All applicants should meet the minimum stated qualifications. Applications which will not meet stated qualifications will not be processed

Bachelor degree programmes are scheduled to start from October to July for each academic year while all other programmes including Postgraduate Diploma starts from September to June
