### **Field Assistant (2 Posts)**

The College of African Wildlife Management, Mweka wishes to announce two positions for Field Assistant to support the implementation of a three-year project titled **“Bee-Pollinator monitoring Project”**. The project seeks to develop understanding on the status and trends of bee pollinator and their interactions to plant communities. Specifically, the project will assess the diversity, abundance, and distribution of bee pollinators’ species; create some initial information about bee-plant interactions; and strengthen capacity of the Tanzanian scientific community. The project is financially supported by the JRS Biodiversity Foundation.

#### **Duty station**

The recruited persons will base in Moshi but fieldwork will be carried out in Arusha and Kilimanjaro regions.

#### **Main Duties and Responsibilities**

The position entails but is not limited to the following duties and responsibilities:

- Assist researchers in the collection of the specimens and other types of data in the field;
- Assist researchers in the preparation and handling of the collected specimens in the laboratory;
- Assist in organizing field trips and follow-up work;
- Maintaining and handling project's field equipment;
- Any other related duties as assigned by supervisor.

### **Required Qualifications and Skills**

- Certificate in Wildlife Management, Wildlife Tourism or Beekeeping from recognized institutions;
- Fluent in English and Kiswahili languages (both written and spoken);
- At least one (1) year of relevant work experience;
- Age limit: not exceeding 35 years

- Excellent analytical skills;
- Ability to handle extra duties; and
- Ability to demonstrate self-management
